

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


Allocation of funds to Programme priorities




Budget allocation to priorities

Options & Flexibility offered by the Interreg Regulation

Article 19 (5) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059

*Following the consultation of and the approval by the monitoring committee and in compliance with Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1060, the managing authority **may transfer** during the programming period an amount of **up to 10 % of the initial allocation of a priority and no more than 5 % of the programme budget to another priority of the same Interreg programme.***






Number of core projects based on allocated funds





Planning third call: First considerations

- **Consultations** are at the centre of active support to applicants;
- Carefully planned **timelines** with more time for preparing applications are appreciated;
- **Webinars** ensure easily accessible information;
- It's important to keep **balancing general & detailed information** at webinars;
- More explanation of the **application process & contracting** seems useful;
- It's important to continue building knowledge among applicants about **EUSBSR and engaging PACs**.



Survey among applicants: support by MA/JS

- **Gateway for applicants**

90% of responding applicants found it very easy, easy or neutral to find the information they needed

- **Video tutorials**

50% of respondents made use of them

- **Matchmaking platform**

1/3 of the applicants used the platform to look for partners or project ideas

Planning third call: First considerations

- **Gateway for applicants** is the central information point;
- Guiding applicants through **application process and document sections** is a continuous goal;
- It's important to keep supporting those who struggle with handling **interactive pdf forms**;
- While keeping a close eye on use of **tutorials**, adding transcripts shall meet varied needs of applicants better;
- **Matchmaking platform** is an important tool for partner search and project idea development.
