THEMATIC FOCUS.

We co-finance projects under
nine objectives within four priorities.

PRIORITY 1 INNOVATIVE SOCIETIES

1.1 Resilient economies and communities

Actions that help to avoid unwanted external impacts, withstand them or recover quickly from them.

1.2 Responsive public services

Actions that improve organisational set-ups and processes to respond to public needs and to deliver less bureaucratic and more cost-efficient public services.

PRIORITY 2 WATER-SMART SOCIETIES

2.1 Sustainable waters

Actions that improve the state of water in the region and make its management more sustainable.

2.2 Blue economy

Actions on sustainable use of fresh and sea waters as well as marine resources in innovative business development in emerging and established sectors.

PRIORITY 3 CLIMATE-NEUTRAL SOCIETIES

3.1 Circular economy

Actions that facilitate the shift from linear to circular resource use.

3.2 Energy transition

Actions for the decarbonisation of energy systems in the region in order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

3.3 Smart green mobility

Actions that support green and well-functioning mobility systems.

PRIORITY 4 COOPERATION GOVERNANCE

4.1 Project platforms

Actions that bring the results of various projects to stakeholders in the Baltic Sea region in a structured way.

4.2 Macro-regional governance

Actions that implement and strengthen governance and communication activities in the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR).

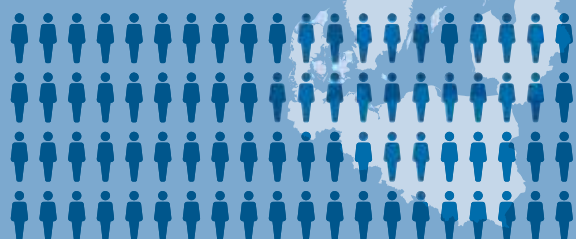
