

WE'RE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATIONS:



Everyday activities to protect biodiversity and prevent the effects of climate change in the Kokoszki district

- focused on making rational decisions in everyday life, in the workplace and during recreation.
- The main objective of the project was to promote the fashion for self-reducing consumption.
- mobilized local community for activities related to the protection of natural resources.

Educational and promotional activities

- the series of open meetings and workshops addressed to the community of the Kokoszki District.



Activities at the regional level



The initial phase of a broader educational task called WebBaltica

- popularize knowledge of the natural and cultural heritage of the Baltic Sea Region
 - the promotion of values of the Region
- mobilizing local communities for activities related to the protection of natural resources.

- The exhibition summarizing the first stage of the project "WebBaltica on the way"
 - educational field workshops for kindergartens



Plastic Free Ocean - raising the global threat

This project addressed the growing pollution of the Baltic Sea and contributed to minimize pollution of the global ocean from plastic litter

This was done through a combination of

- policy-oriented measures
- awareness-raising public campaign
 - monitoring activities
- assistance to identified target groups from private and municipal sector in switching to plastic-free alternatives
