Project overview The BSR Cultural Pearls project, co-funded by the EU's Interreg programme, aims to strengthen **social resilience** in Baltic Sea Region municipalities by harnessing the potential of **local assets of culture and creativity**. The project contains several key components, including a repository of good practices on increasing social resilience through culture, and **inspires municipalities** in creating their own social resilience action plans. Additionally, the project offers tools specifically designed to help municipalities develop **tailored social resilience plans**, a peer-mentoring programme to support municipalities in implementing their social resilience plans, and the BSR Cultural Pearls Award, which recognises outstanding culture-driven social resilience work developed by municipalities.
