






- first meeting: **25 October**, next ones: 16 and 23 November
- over **30 participants**, including residents, entrepreneurs, activists, NGOs, and local officials
  - Il representatives working in city institutions
  - 8 district council representatives
  - 6 NGO representatives
  - 3 business' representatives
  - 3 university representatives
  - 2 community gardens' representatives
- sustainable urban development in three areas
  - urban gardening and green spaces
  - o zero waste, circular economy, reducing waste
  - mapping sustainable businesses







how to grow herbs, vegetables and fruits in urban conditions, while also enriching biodiversity in our immediate surroundings

how to use what we already have and give products a second life by producing less waste

mapping and promoting places operating in the spirit of sustainable development





































## First results - Gdynia 2035: Urban Garden

- we talk openly about the need for change in the neighbourhood
- there's **greenery** wherever you go; trees, shrubs and plants on central reservation strips, green walls and roofs
- "green walks" as a weekly activity within the districts
- we know our resources mapping the greenery
- social gardens are a place where locals can bond
- semipermeable surfaces as a standard
- the city supports and popularizes green initiatives
- community gardens within every district
- kindergartens and schools working together with community gardens







### First results - Gdynia 2035: reThink

- community life > individual life
  - space sharing
  - more profits (free- and quality time, relations, non-measurable values)
  - lower costs sharing some items and chosen responsibilities (looking after kids, common spaces)
  - lending over owning
- home appliances supplied with a green energy
- sustainable tourism "**no trace tourism**" (3city problem with not separated trash left behind)
- collaborative city collective farming supported by the city
- entrepreneurs open to zero waste (e.g. urCup, Wrocław)
- circular model in regards to **food containers** (e.g. catering)








#### First results - GreenLocator


- green city planning first and foremost
  - o planning urban space, but also events, procurements
- spots and events in the zero waste model
- cross-generational network of educators
- grey water in city infrastructure
  - bathrooms, public toilets
- mapping green businesses
- local markets in every district
  - supporting local producers
- drinkable water in the city space
- green **certification** for restaurants, cafes








