





Prosper BSR

For host countries, welcoming a high number of refugees brings unique challenges. For refugees, integrating into a new community - especially finding employment - is a crucial step in rebuilding their lives. In countries like Lithuania, Latvia and Poland, many refugees face difficulties accessing job opportunities, while businesses experience workforce shortages. Without strong regional cooperation to bridge this gap, refugees remain isolated, and communities miss out on the mutual benefits of integration and growth.

Prosper BSR = Bridging Gaps Refugee Integration and Regional Cooperation



In Lithuania, Latvia and Poland, many refugees struggle to find work, while businesses need employees. Without a bridge between them, refugees remain isolated, and employers miss out on the benefits of a diverse workforce. Business Support Organisations are stepping in to act as that crucial bridge.

Bridging Employment Gaps



To tackle this, Prosper BSR unites governments, NGOs, community organizations, and businesses to create inclusive pathways for refugees.


By collaborating regionally and across borders, this EU project, is building sustainable solutions that open doors for integration and job placement.

We trained staff from business support organizations in Latvia, Lithuania and Poland, raised awareness in 49 institutions from 9 countries and signed 24 Memorandums of understanding with multiple stakeholders such as: chambers of commerce, ministries, NGOs, state revenue services, welfare associations, diversity development groups, innovation centres, charities, municipality and city representatives, to make refugee integration in the labour market a shared mission. We compiled all of our learnings in a mobile app called Prosper BSR , along with an additional chapter on Refugees as Entrepreneurs".
