
- Owner of building responsible for a long time
- We need information about chemical content "for future reference"








Local results



Percentage of all products used in Stockholm that have received the assessment *Avoid*




Percentage of all products used in Stockholm that have received the assessment *Avoid* because of carcinogenicity (H350)

Importance of EU policy

- Make information available
- Knowing that regulation is coming paves the way for voluntary measures
- There needs to be a ban on the most hazardous chemicals (e.g. PFAS)
- The accepted levels for other substances need to be lower
