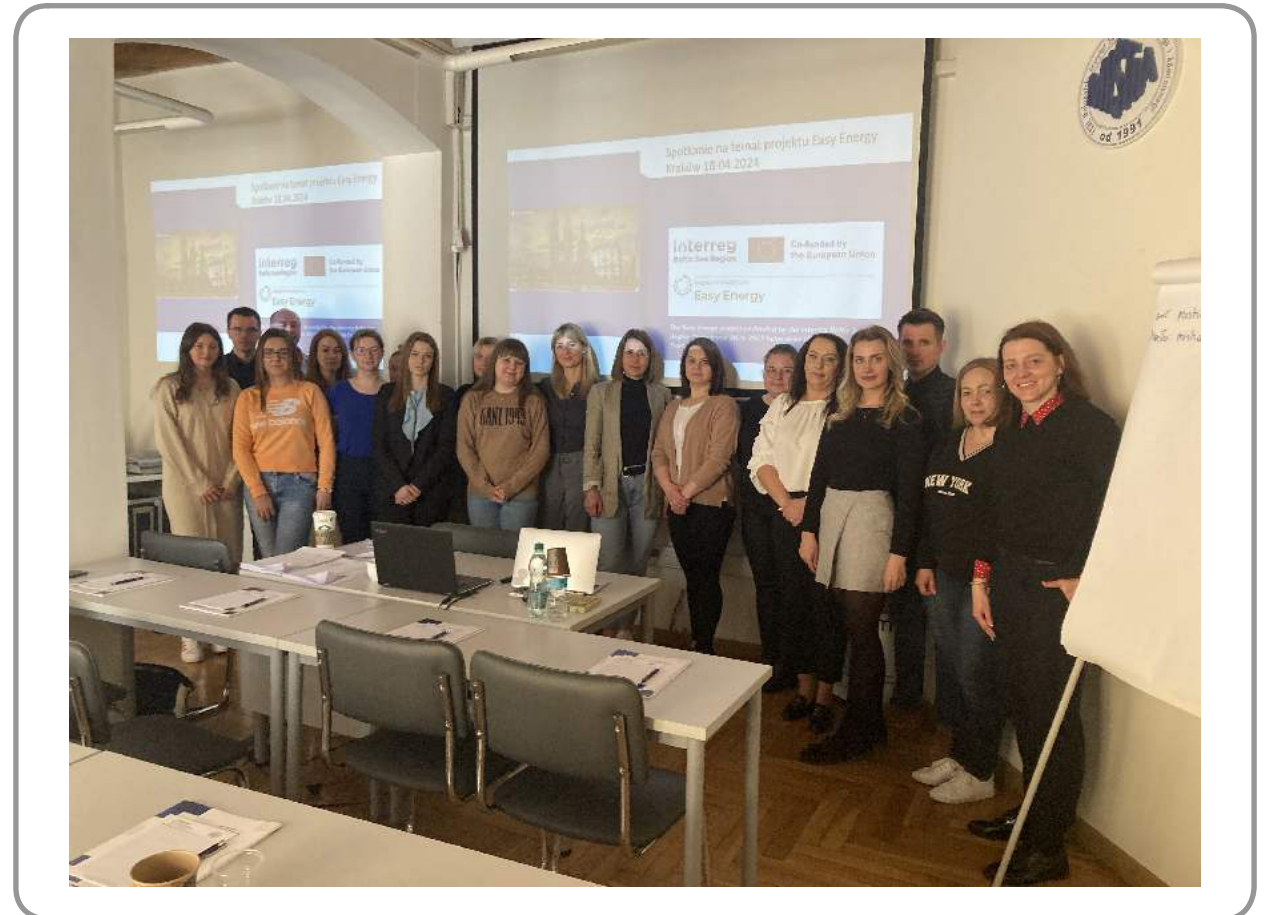


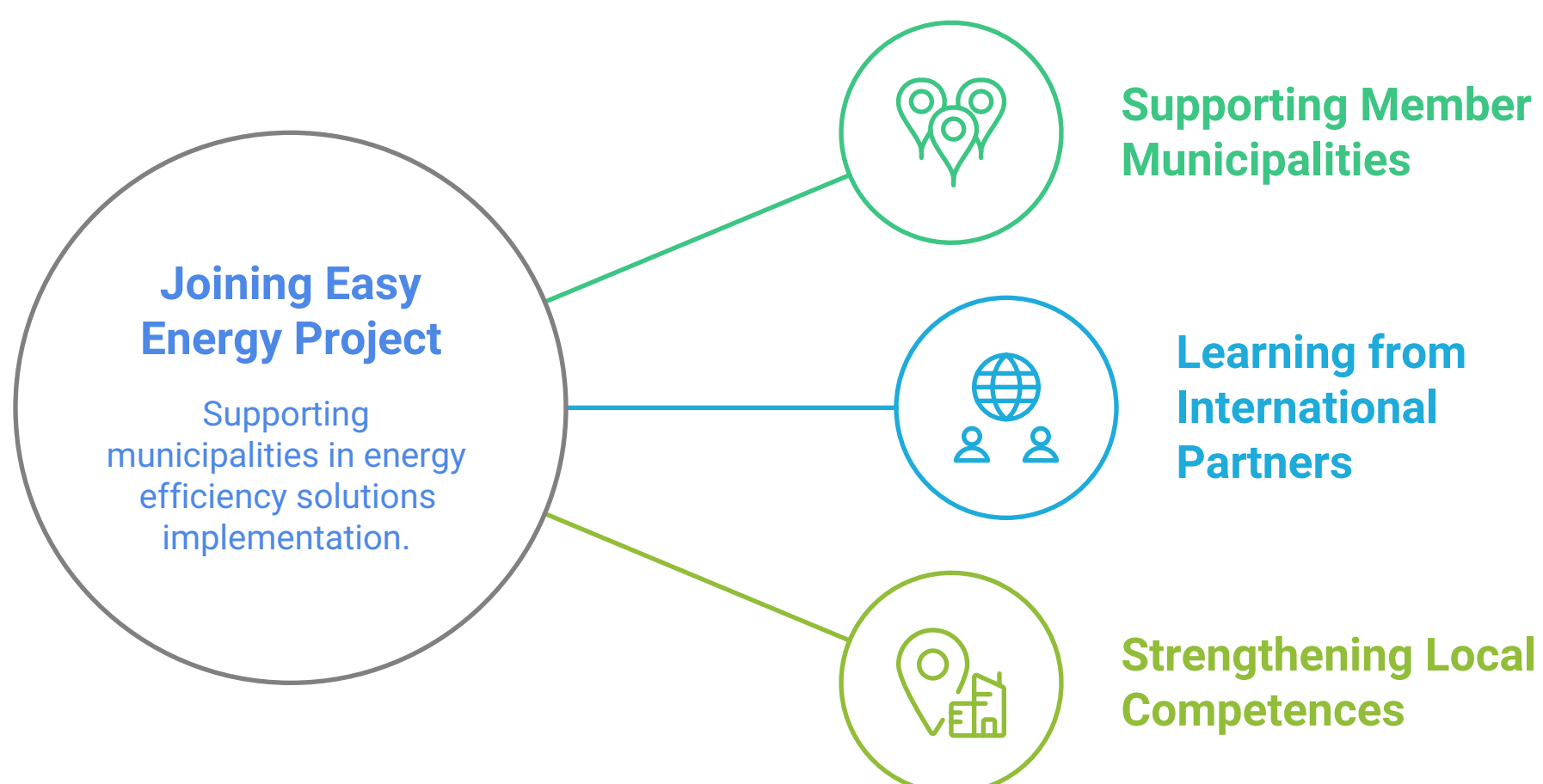
Interview with Klaudia Rogowiec, Project Manager, Otulina Podkrakowska Association (PP9).

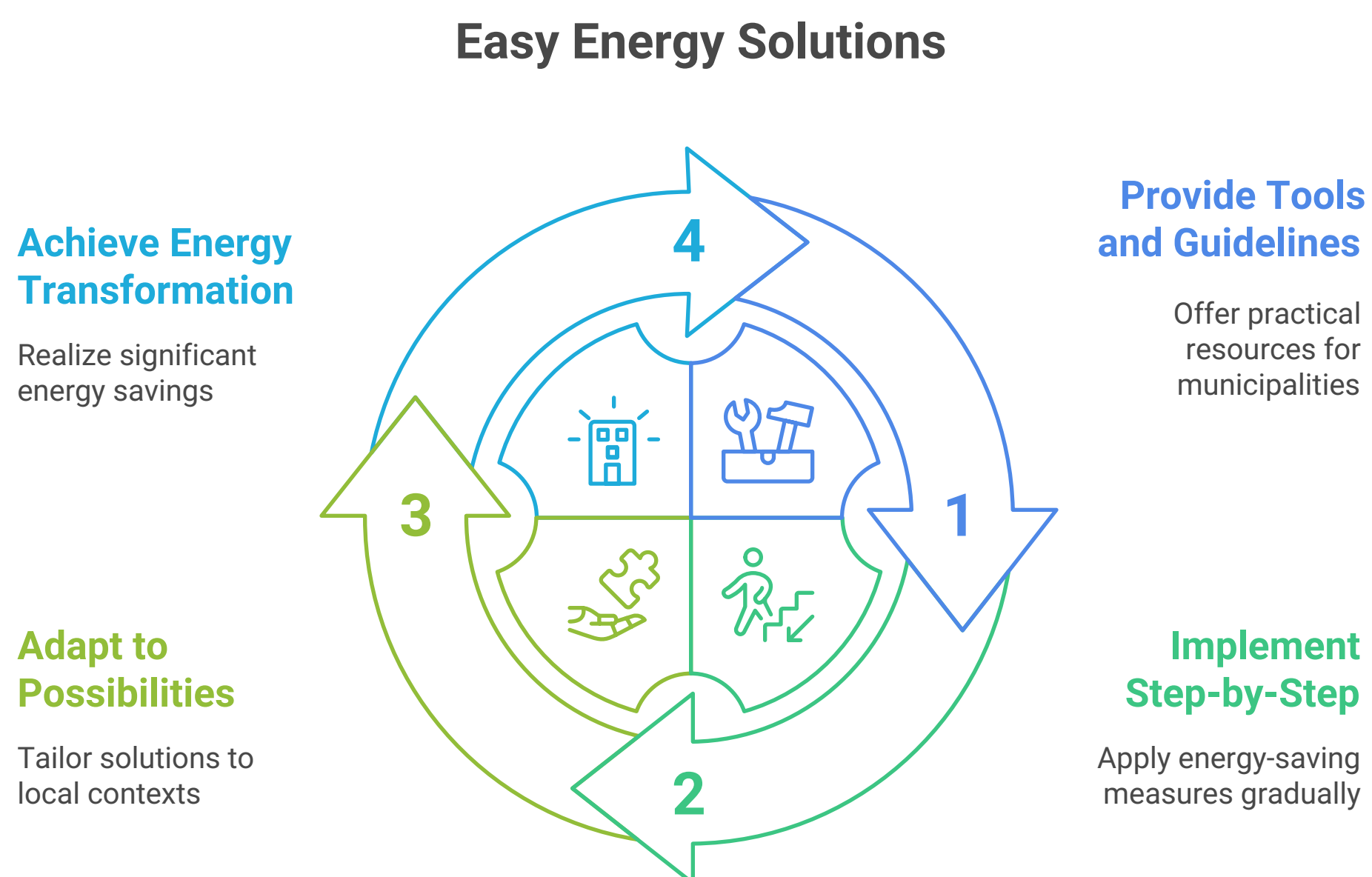


2. How would you describe the challenge that Easy Energy is tackling in 2-3 sentences?

International cooperation is extremely valuable to us – thanks to it we learn about different approaches and solutions used in other countries, which are often simple but very effective.
